

## Book-o-mat



This self-service device allows to collect books previously ordered in the library. The patron places an order through the library system. When the book is prepared for borrowing, the staff place it in the booko-mat and the order is marked in the library system as ready for collection. The library system shall notify the reader of the possibility to collect a copy. The reader logs onto the device using a library card (which may be based on a barcode or RFID technology). The device automatically opens the locker with ordered book. A library card or electronic ID is required to open the locker. The device is equipped with lockable lockers, a touch screen and a library card reader. To be placed inside or outside the building under a canopy.

## **Device specifications:**

- outdoor standard version: powder-painted stainless steel 1,5mm, main unit 18 lockers – length 1000 mm, height 2035 mm, width 610 mm, mass: 152 kg. secondary unit 24 lockers – length 900 mm, height 2035 mm, width 610 mm, mass: 134 kg.
- outdoor optional version: powder-painted stainless steel 1,5mm, main unit 16 lockers – length 1000 mm, height 190 mm, width 610 mm, mass: 132 kg. secondary unit 22 lockers – length 900 mm, height 190 mm, width 610 mm, mass: 114 kg.
- electrolocks for each locker together with controls,
- shatterproof locker doors,
- connection to the computer network: LAN, RJ45,
- supported card standards: Mifare, bar code, 2D QR code
- card reader adapted to the requirements of the library,
- 17-inch LCD touch screen,
- receipt printer (optional)
- standard voltage supply 230V/50Hz
- power consumption below 500 W,
- choice of colours (standard RAL)
- optional additional lightning





The book-o-mat can be composed of 1 to 5 modules, which can be combined in any order.

## Requirements for the ordering party:

- Purchasing a license for the SIP2 protocol from the library system provider.
- Supplying 230 V power to the location of the book-o-mat,
- Supplying a LAN connection
